Due to Covid-19 travel concerns, the Youth tour will be held in-state for 2021. A week of activities begins in Denver on June 15. Students will have the opportunity to visit: Tri-State G&T, United Power, the Denver Mint, partake in a walking tour of Denver, and visit our state capitol building before heading to Devils Thumb Ranch near Grand Lake. While at the ranch, students will tour a Solar generating facility, a Hydro Generation plant and take a raft trip on the Colorado River.

Youth Leadership Camp

On July 17-22, 2021, a total of about one hundred students are chosen and sponsored by Rural Electric Cooperatives from all over Colorado, Kansas, Wyoming and Oklahoma to attend the Youth Leadership Camp. The camp is designed to provide a better understanding of cooperatives, legislative processes, energy prices, power generation, and the rural electric cooperative program. It also focuses on developing leadership skills to handle the challenges of the future. The camp, run by the students, is a lot of fun, but also provides an excellent learning experience. Field trips are planned to tour a large open-pit coal mine and an electric generation power plant. There is also time for fun and sightseeing. Free time is taken up with volleyball, swimming, whitewater rafting, dancing, a banquet and meeting many new friends.
